### III. Project Plan Summary

**A. Provide a brief description of the project and how the project supported flood response or will support future flood recovery and flood mitigation activities. This is a summary of Tab B - Project Plan.**

Fremont County Secondary Roads Department has identified 56 sites that are damaged due to 2019 flooding. This project will support flood recovery and consists of repairing damaged roads and bridges to pre-flood condition. Damages primarily consist of the erosion of roadways and the road substructure, road rock having been washed away, structural damage to bridges, and erosion to bridge footings/embankments due to flooding. Repairs are in various stages of work; most repairs are underway or have yet to begin due to lingering floodwaters. Site information, damage description and cost estimate details can be found in the project plan.

**B. Provide a brief description of the financial assistance need through the Flood Recovery Fund.**

Financial assistance is needed through the Flood Recovery Fund because of a cash-flow shortage within Fremont County. It is expected that Public Assistance funding will be available in the future to reimburse repair costs, but currently the County is unable to finance needed repairs due to a shortage of funding.

**C. Explain how financial assistance through the Flood Recovery Fund is essential to meet the necessary expenses or serious needs of the applicant related to flood response, flood recovery, and flood mitigation.**

Financial Assistance through the Flood Recovery Fund is essential so that Fremont County can continue to finance the repair costs of flood damaged roads. This assistance is necessary because County resources are depleted due to 2019 flooding and the associated costs to repair damages.

**D. Provide details of any additional funds that can be applied to the project.**

Public Assistance funds as well as State of Iowa Executive Council funds (State 10% match to disaster related project costs) are anticipated to be available once FEMA project worksheets have been obligated and funds transmitted to the County. These funding sources are anticipated to provide a total of 85% of total project costs. 15% of project costs are the responsibility of Fremont County.
