
PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS,** ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 23, 2008 AND CONTINUING, SEVERE STORM SYSTEMS MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND
- WHEREAS,** THESE STORM SYSTEMS SPAWNED SEVERE WEATHER TO INCLUDE HEAVY RAINS, AND SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS, CAUSING DAMAGES AND RELATED IMPACTS TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY INCLUDING RESIDENCES, BUSINESSES, INFRASTRUCTURE, AND AGRICULTURE, IN LOUISA COUNTY; AND
- WHEREAS,** LOCAL OFFICIALS AND RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY THE SEVERE WEATHER NEED ASSISTANCE TO INCLUDE FLOOD RESPONSE RESOURCES; AND
- WHEREAS,** REPORTS FORWARDED BY LOCAL AND STATE OFFICIALS INDICATE THAT STATE ASSISTANCE WILL BE NEEDED TO RESPOND TO AND RECOVER FROM THE EFFECTS OF THIS EVENT.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM A STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR LOUISA COUNTY IN THE STATE OF IOWA, FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED REASONS. THIS PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AUTHORIZES LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT TO RENDER GOODS AND SUFFICIENT AID TO ASSIST THOSE AREAS IN THIS TIME OF NEED.
