## PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, ON SUNDAY MAY 25, 2008 AND CONTINUING, SEVERE STORM

SYSTEMS MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND

WHEREAS, THIS STORM SYSTEM SPAWNED SEVERE WEATHER TO INCLUDE

TORNADOES, HEAVY RAINS, WIND, HAIL, AND SEVERE

THUNDERSTORMS CAUSING SEVERE DAMAGES, FLOODING AND

RELATED IMPACTS TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY

INCLUDING RESIDENCES, BUSINESSES, INFRASTRUCTURE, AND

AGRICULTURE; AND

WHEREAS, LOCAL OFFICIALS AND RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY THIS SEVERE


WEATHER NEED ASSISTANCE TO DEAL WITH THE IMPACTS OF THESE STORMS INCLUDING SAND, SANDBAGS, AND DEBRIS REMOVAL FROM DAMAGED STRUCTURES AND TREES; AND

WHEREAS, SURVEYS AND REPORTS FORWARDED BY LOCAL OFFICIALS

INDICATE THAT STATE ASSISTANCE WILL BE NEEDED TO RESPOND TO AND RECOVER FROM THE EFFECTS OF THESE STORMS. THIS PROCLAMATION ALSO ACTIVATES THE STATE INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM NEEDED TO ASSIST ELIGIBLE

RESIDENTS AND MINIMIZE THEIR HARDSHIP:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM A STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR ADAMS, BENTON, BOONE, CERRO GORDO, CHICKASAW, CLARKE, CRAWFORD, DALLAS, FLOYD, FRANKLIN, HARDIN, JASPER, MARSHALL, POLK, STORY, TAMA, WEBSTER, WINNESHIEK COUNTIES IN THE STATE OF IOWA, FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED REASONS. THIS PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AUTHORIZES STATE GOVERNMENTS TO RENDER GOODS AND SUFFICIENT AID TO ASSIST THOSE AREAS IN THIS TIME OF NEED.
