
PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS,** ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 6, 2010 A SEVERE WINTER STORM SYSTEM MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND
- WHEREAS,** THIS STORM SYSTEM, COMBINED WITH THE LASTING EFFECTS OF A PREVIOUS SEVERE WINTER STORM SYSTEM ON DECEMBER 22, 2009, PRODUCED HEAVY SNOW AND BLIZZARD CONDITIONS, CAUSING DAMAGES AND RELATED IMPACTS TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE; AND
- WHEREAS,** ON JANUARY 15, 2010 I ISSUED MY PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER FOR ADAIR, CLARKE, MONTGOMERY, PAGE AND TAYLOR COUNTIES; AND
- WHEREAS,** LOCAL OFFICIALS IMPACTED BY THE SEVERE WEATHER NEED ASSISTANCE WITH EMERGENCY SNOW REMOVAL FROM COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL ROADS; AND
- WHEREAS,** STATE ASSISTANCE WILL BE NEEDED TO MINIMIZE THE HARDSHIP AND RECOVER FROM THE IMPACTS OF THIS STORM:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM A STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY TO BE EXTENDED FOR THE COUNTIES LISTED ABOVE UNTIL MARCH 11, 2010. THIS PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AUTHORIZES LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT TO RENDER GOODS AND SUFFICIENT AID TO ASSIST THOSE AREAS IN THIS TIME OF NEED.


