PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, ON TUESDAY, JUNE 1, 2010 AND CONTINUING, SEVERE STORMS SYSTEMS MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND

WHEREAS, THESE STORM SYSTEMS SPAWNED SEVERE WEATHER TO INCLUDE TORNADOES, HEAVY RAINS AND FLOODING, FLASH FLOODING CONDITIONS, AND RELATED IMPACTS TO THE TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE; AND


WHEREAS, IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OFFICIALS IN CASS COUNTY HAVE CONDUCTED SURVEYS AND ASSESSMENTS WHICH INDICATE THAT SEVERAL FEDERAL-AID ROUTES HAVE SUSTAINED DAMAGE. THIS DAMAGE INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, SLIDES OF ROADWAY EMBANKMENTS, STRUCTURAL BRIDGE DAMAGE, SHOULDER WASHOUTS AND UNDERMINING OF PAVEMENTS. EMERGENCY RELIEF FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION ARE NEEDED TO RECOVER FROM THE EFFECTS OF THESE DAMAGES; AND

WHEREAS, THIS PROCLAMATION IS REQUIRED UNDER 23 C.F.R SECTION 668.11 AND BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PPM SECTION 600.08 AND BY THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION EMERGENCY RELIEF MANUAL IN ORDER FOR THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO REQUEST EMERGENCY FEDERAL RELIEF FUNDS FOR DAMAGE ON FEDERAL AID ROUTES WITHIN THE ABOVE COUNTY:


