Progress Report for Downtown Levee Improvements Project Project Narrative Description of Significant Activities November 1, 2015 to April 30, 2016

Work progresses towards construction of the Cedar Falls Downtown Levee Improvement Project. On March 20, 2015 the City's consultant, AECOM, submitted 65% plans to the US Army Corps of Engineers for review. As of April 30, 2016, no official review comments or approval from the Corps have been received. The project is currently making its way through internal channels at the Corps towards permit issuance. In particular, the City is awaiting approval of the Corps' internal review plan at the Mississippi Valley Division's Headquarters in Vicksburg, Mississippi. Once official comments on the plans have been received from the Corps of Engineers, AECOM will address comments and work towards producing final plans and specifications and beginning the public letting process.

Asbestos testing and abatement occurred on three structures acquired by the City. The City then had a public letting for the demolition of the structures. The demolition of these structures is now complete.

Originally the City of Cedar Falls had intended to let this project in the summer of 2015. Due to the lengthy review process, the schedule has been pushed back and the project is presently on schedule for a fall 2016 letting with construction to begin in the spring of 2017. Construction is anticipated to last during the 2017 construction season and into the 2018 season. With this new schedule, the project is still on track to be completed prior to December 31, 2018, the date specified in the grant agreement.
