Governor Culver Issues Disaster Proclamation for Humboldt County 29 Counties Now Covered by Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamations

DES MOINES – Governor Chet Culver today issued a disaster proclamation for Humboldt County.

The following 29 counties are now under state disaster proclamations: Buena Vista, Butler, Clay, Davis, Emmet, Hamilton, Howard, Humboldt, Jefferson, Lee, O'Brien, Osceola, Palo Alto, Van Buren, Webster, Cherokee, Decatur, Franklin, Hancock, Mahaska, Marion, Monroe, Polk, Ringgold, Sioux, Taylor, Union, Warren and Wright Counties.

The disaster proclamations authorize the implementation of the State Individual Assistance Grant Program. The state monitors the needs of families after a storm or flooding occurs and then issues the disaster proclamation on an as-needed basis. The Governor urges people impacted by recent flooding to contact their county emergency management coordinators to report damages so the state is aware of the needs of each county.
