

## PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2019, and continuing thereafter, widespread flooding and flash flooding events began to impact the State of Iowa due to rapid snow melt combined with heavy rains, which are causing dangerous flood conditions across much of the state; and

WHEREAS, Muscatine County suffered significant damage from this event; and

disaster who cannot be helped by other means of financial assistance and for whom federal assistance under the Stafford Act is either not available or does not adequately meet the needs of the citizens in the disaster area; and Emergency Management by the emergency management coordinator in the affected county indicate that state individual assistance pursuant to Iowa Code § 29C.20A and 441 Iowa Admin. Code 58.2 (1) is needed to assist certain individuals and families adversely affected by the WHEREAS, reports forwarded to the Iowa Department of Homeland Security and

Because of this, they provide legal justification for the issuance of a Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency pursuant to Iowa Code § 29C.6 (1). WHEREAS, these conditions threaten the public peace, health, and safety of citizens of

by the power and authority vested in me by the Iowa Constitution Art. IV, §§ 1, 8 and Iowa Code § 29C.6 (1), and all other applicable laws, do hereby proclaim a **STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY** for Muscatine County and do hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT** the following: NOW, THEREFORE, I, KIMBERLY K. REYNOLDS, Governor of the State of Iowa,

the disaster response and recovery aspects of the Iowa Department of Homeland Security and those citizens located in the disaster counties available state resources, supplies, equipment, and materials as are reasonably necessary to assist applicable to the counties affected by this disaster and authorizes the use and deployment of all Emergency Management's Iowa Emergency Response Plan and those additional response plans cases of Presidential Disaster Declarations, this Proclamation of Disaster Emergency activates SECTION ONE. As required by Iowa Code § 29C.6 (1), (10) and 42 U.S.C. § 5170 in
