Benton Township's Fire Station and contents were damaged during 2019 flooding. This project will support flood recovery and consists of repair to the Fire Station structure and replacement of damaged contents. Structure doors, overhead doors & safety sensors, sheet rock, trim, cabinets, water main disconnect, and emergency siren were damaged. Contents damage is widespread with details available in the project plan. Structure repair costs are estimated to be \$82,000 and contents repair/replacement \$200,000.

**B. Provide a brief description of the financial assistance need through the Flood Recovery Fund.**

Financial assistance is needed through the Flood Recovery Fund because of a cash-flow shortage within Fremont County to include Benton Township. It is no longer expected that Public Assistance funding will be available in the future to reimburse repair costs. There is no longer a FEMA project for the fire station and contents. Benton County asked for the project to be withdrawn since FEMA was not likely going to fund the project anyway. The reason is because FEMA placed an "obtain and maintain" insurance requirement on this building, from a previous flood event, and Benton Twp did not maintain this policy (cancelled it at some point).

Currently the Township is unable to finance needed repairs due to a shortage of funding.

Financial Assistance through the Flood Recovery Fund is essential so that Benton County Twp is able to finance repair costs to the Fire Station. This assistance is necessary because County and Township resources are depleted due to 2019 flooding and associated costs to repair damages.
