
IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF IOWA

PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS,** On Monday January 31, 2011 and continuing, a severe winter weather storm system moved across portions of Iowa; and
- WHEREAS,** the storm system produced blizzard conditions consisting of large amounts of snow, high winds and dangerously low temperatures; and
- WHEREAS,** surveys and reports forwarded by local officials in Cedar, Dubuque and Scott counties indicate that state assistance will be needed to respond to and recover from the effects of these storms.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Terry E. Branstad, Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim a state of disaster emergency for Cedar, Dubuque and Scott counties in the State of Iowa, for the aforementioned reasons. This proclamation of disaster emergency authorizes state governments to render goods and sufficient aid to assist those areas in this time of need.
