# Basic Plans, What are they?

The base (Basic) plan provides an overview of a jurisdiction's preparedness, response, and recovery strategies. It summarizes the basic tasks to prepare for emergencies and disasters and defines how the plan is developed and maintained.

HSEMD has used CPG-101 as a guide for planning standards since 2010, current version is 3.0 from 2021

HSEMD reviews plans to meet minimum standards

Beyond the standards, plans should be tailored to your needs
